
Hohm Sahaj Mandir (USA)

1. Acoustic Panels for Leela Mandir

We have found over the past several years that the noise level in Leela Mandir is very high due to the high ceilings, concrete floors and open plan for the building. During meals in the dining room it has often been difficult to hear even the person sitting next to you! We have found a company that makes excellent acoustic panels that can be applied to the ceilings which will reduce the echoes and ambient noise significantly.



1. Strawball hut for children: in progress

The aim of the construction is to provide a welcoming space for children coming with their parents to visit La Ferme de Jutreau and which can be used all over the year.

An architect did the design and is directing the building work.

The insulation is made of strawball which provide high energy efficiency for a low material cost rate. The form of the building is round in order to offer an inclusive feeling for children.

This construction is still in progress. Please find hereafter some photos of the work.



2. Stove installation in the big house and the small house

The aim of this project has been to install a wood stove in the little house (including the tube in the chimney) where the Association is hosting guests and one another in the reception room of the big house where people are gathering in winter. These two wood stoves are now functioning properly with wood cut on the property and this avoids the use of electric heaters which are very expensive and not environmental friendly.
