Hohm Sahaj Mandir (USA)

1. New professional water pumping system & participation on new well pump When the new system was being installen, the well company determined that our old well booser pumt (the pump that moves the water up the hill as opposed tot he pump that pulls it up from the ground), was rapidly failing, and that we also needed a new well









Hohm Sahaj Trust (Indien)

1. New Borewell and Pump

We started the building and construction at the Anapurna plot by digging a new borewell for water. The new well is 500 feet deep and accesses 3 lines of ground water. We hope that this could be almost enough water to supply the construction and serve as the main water source for the new buildings with guests rooms, bathrooms, kitchen etc. First we drilled out this giant well, had it secured with piping inside, and then proceeded to fit it with a groundwater imersion pump which would stay almost 480ft in the ground. The pump is connected to a line of plastic piping, electrical wires, and rope, and lowered into deep into the well. One the pump is secure, it is then connected to the electric supply and motor to have access to the ground water.

In order to make space for the large Borewell truck to enter we first had to break down the back wall and clear the trees and land using a JCB.





Starting the drilling with the borewell truck, it attaches new channels and uses an air motor to break deeper into the ground. This process goes on for about 7 hours.

2. Construction

Since a couple of years Triveni II has had the idea to build a new building with guest rooms and a muti purpose hall on the Anapurna property. This is so we can host guests and groups, have a more functional dining hall and kitchen space, and in the future be able to generate better income for Triveni II to support our existing charity projects and begin new charity projects. With the new building this year we have finalised plans with the architect, civil engineers and builders. We have paid everyone for completion of stage 1 and 2 of the planning and marking stages. We started with digging for the foundation holes. As soon as business reopens we hope to continue with a good momentum and speed to complete the project in 4 sections – Ground floor Dining Hall, Top floor multipurpose hall and studio. 2nd Building: ground floor rooms, 1st floor rooms.

3. Septic tank and building a new outlet system

Unexpectedly this year again the septic tank became full and starting overflowing back into the house through the toilets. We had break through the floor to access it again and then empty it. Since this problem happened again we had to go deeper into the issue and the result being having to design and build a new septic fluid outlet system, which should outstand forever.
